FABRICS & MATERIALS



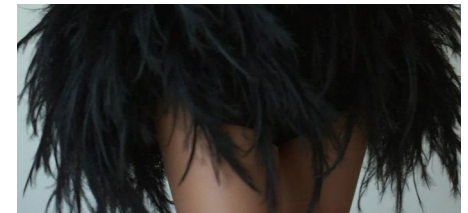
SKIRT

The skirt will be much more detailed and rich of details. It will have an asymmetric shape and will have multiple layers:

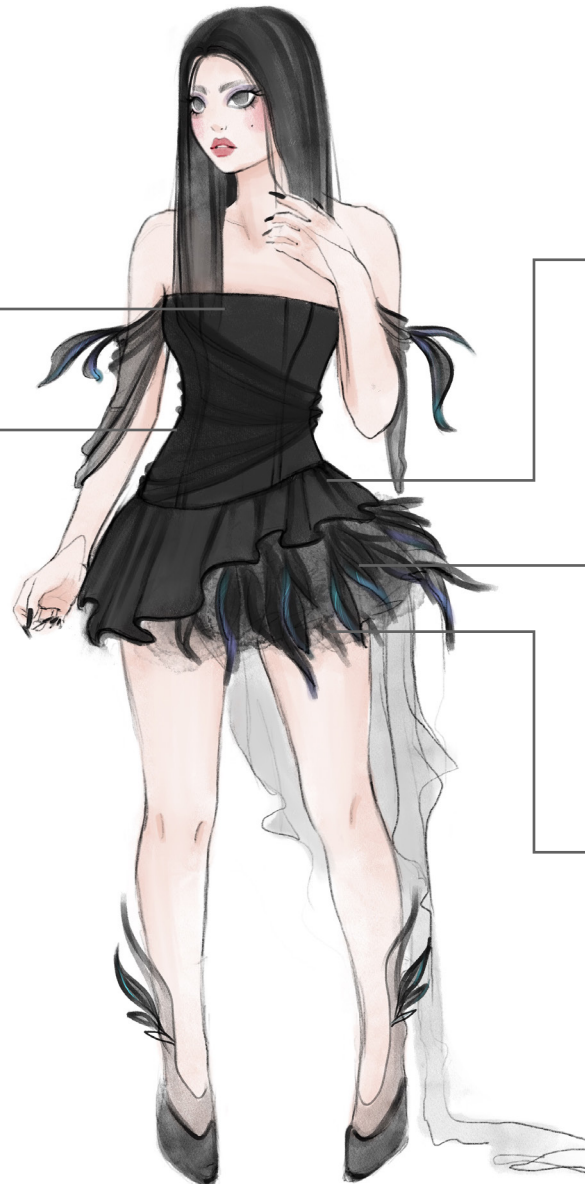
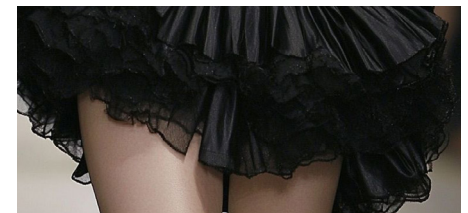
- **1st layer** will be done in black velvet and it will have this shape:

For the shoes I will try to replace the current boots with some black velvet heels. The heels will have feathers and thorns.



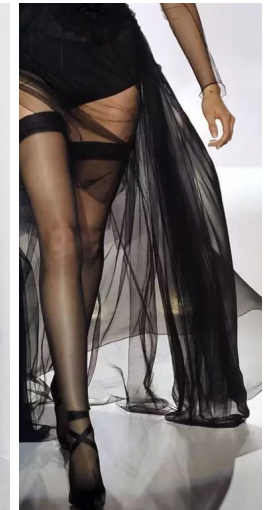
SLEEVES IN MESH & FEATHERS

The dress will have small sleeves made in black sheer fabric. I will also add some feathers to them.



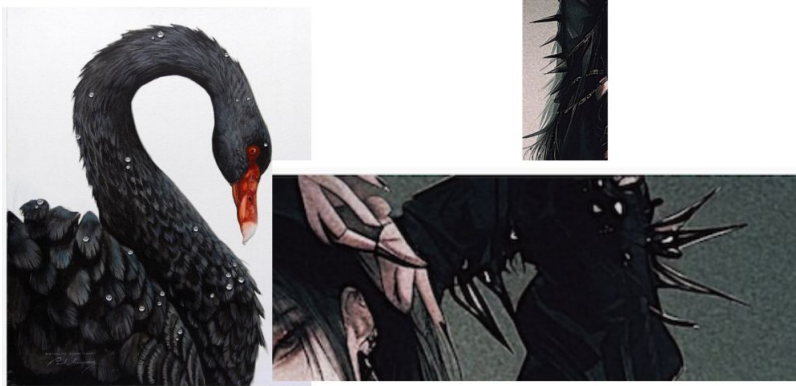
LONG BACK OF THE SKIRT

Story Concept

black swan theory



英語にはかつて、無駄な努力を表す言葉として、「黒い白鳥(ブラックスワン)を探すようなものだ」ということわざがあった。それほど黒い白鳥はいないと信じられていたが、1697年に実際にオーストラリアでコクチョウ = 「黒い白鳥」が発見され、当時の人々からは驚きをもって迎えられた。この発見によって「常識を疑うこと」、「物事を一変させること」、「自分を絶対視しないこと」の象徴として使われるようになった。またこれを下地にして、「ありえないと思われていたことが突然発生すると、予想されていた場合よりも影響が苛烈になる」というブラック・スワン理論が提唱された。

In English, there was a proverb that expressed futile efforts: "It's like looking for a black swan." It was believed that there were no black swans, but in 1697, black swans were actually discovered in Australia. This discovery was met with astonishment by the people of the time. As a result of this discovery, the black swan came to be used as a symbol of "questioning common sense," "transforming things," and "not seeing oneself as infallible." Building on this, the Black Swan theory was proposed, which posits that "when something deemed impossible suddenly occurs, its impact is more severe than if it had been anticipated."
